**For First Time Participants Only

Stipend upon completion: \$750

(12 spots available)

To participate:

- You must be an enrolled educator in the Educational Partnership program
- You must apply to participate in the Certificate program using this form: <u>'25- '26</u>
 <u>Ed Partnerships Certificate Program Application</u>
- The 12 Certificate Program + Stipend spots are prioritized for educators enrolled with a participating Club 21 family; if spots remain, they will be opened to any other participants that have applied on a first- come- first- serve basis.
- Once you are notified that you have been selected for a spot, you will be asked to sign a participant agreement form outlining the requirements.
- If applications exceed 12 participants, a waitlist will be set up and educators will be notified if a spot opens for them, as soon as possible. Educators interested in receiving a stipend are still encouraged to participate and will receive a certificate of completion, if all the components outlined below are completed.

Guidelines to be completed and submitted no later than May 15, 2026:

- Total of 25 hours (minimum)
 - ** Must Do= indicates that the activity is required
 - **May Do= indicates that the requirement can count towards your total hours, but are <u>NOT</u> required or can be completed in any combination with other "May Do" activities
 - Must Do-- 3 hours of core content coursework (each will also have an activity to be submitted): Pre- recorded lectures and activities available on Teachable
 - May Do—Up to 15 hours of elective course content or activities (each will also have an activity to be submitted): Pre- recorded lectures and activities available on Teachable
 - May Do—Up to 7 hours: Attendance to the Tools for the Journey Conference 2026 (February 28, 2026 from 9:00AM- 5:00PM)



 Must Do—Minimum of 6 hours of participation in live group coaching/ Make & Take Workshops w/ breakfast (offered on 4 Saturdays throughout the year)-- See Below
