## **Student Sessions**

**Session 1:** Understanding the Body, Changes During Puberty, Hygiene & Self-Care, Puberty and Body Review, Types of Relationships, and Identity/ Expression

**Session 2:** Boundaries, Consent, Types of Relationships, Body Ownership/Respecting Others' Bodies, Boundary-Setting Language and Phrases, Autonomy & Saying "No" **Session 3:** Types of Touch and Guidelines/

Rules about Touch, Bodily Autonomy and Safety, Identifying Safe vs. Unsafe Situations.

- Student must be within age range at start of the program.
- Each student/family will receive puberty hygiene kit and books to support at home learning

# **Parent Sessions**

**Session 1:** Intro to course, preview of curriculum, scripts/tips for talking to your tween/teen about bodies, sex, boundaries, and respect

**Session 2:** Supporting hygiene routines for growing bodies/reinforcing boundaries and consent

**Session 3:** Monitoring online access to sexual health content, abuse prevention, and signs of concern, building confidence through everyday practice

- Cost: \$500 includes the 3 student sessions and 3 parent sessions
